Program Outline

There are four units in this certificate

1. Government Functioning in Times of Crisis

Crisis tend to disrupt the role of a government but what is the expectations people have of their government? This unit will broadly reintroduce you to the concept of a Government, the role of governance, government functions and public value. Finally, we will see how governments are tested during a crisis.



2. Introduction to Crises and their Management

COVID19- is a global pandemic and a so called "black swan crisis". It took less than three months to go global. The speed of this crisis and the spillover from health to economy, labour markets, education, trade are all reasons why crisis management is becoming such an important topic. This unit will introduce you to the concept of a crisis and its various phases, the types of crises, crises responses and broad stages of crisis management.





3. Government Responses: Best Practices

While there are many responses to COVID19- we will focus on four responses that we think are most important. These responses focus on the human-centric government: changing the rules of the game, managing perceptions, understanding symbolisms and macroeconomic policy. Examples from the past and present are outlined to show you both short and long-term effects of good and bad practices.

4. Crisis Communication

Very often crisis communication is assumed to be a public relations strategy but this is not true. Using two in-depth cases we will go through the strategies for taking control of communication during a crisis, look at methods to restore confidence, highlight the importance of focusing on wellbeing and show the advantages of using a crisis as an opportunity to showcase values. The examples will give you an idea of what went well in your governments and what are areas you can improve in terms of crisis communication.
