Online Access

Lending Rules

Users must produce a valid student ID card to borrow books

- 1. Periodicals, current and back issues, are not to be issued
- 2. Reference books cannot be borrowed and taken out of the library
- 3. A user may renew a book if it is not requested by any other user
- 4. A fine of 1.00 DH per day may be imposed if an item is not returned within the due date.
- 5. Lost or damaged material will have to be paid by the user
